

## Roman Gods

1. Apollo – The son of Jupiter and Leto, and the twin brother of Diana, he is the God of Music, and is also known as the Archer, the God of Healing and the God of Light
2. Aquilo – North Wind
3. Bacchus – God of Wine and Fertility
4. Ceres – Goddess of Agriculture
5. Cupid – The God of Love
6. Diana – Twin sister of Apollo, she is the Goddess of the Moon, Fertility and of the Hunt
7. Discordia – Goddess of Discord
8. Eurus – East Wind
9. Faunus – The God of Flocks, Sheep
10. Fortuna – Goddess of Fortune and Fate
11. Helios – The Sun God
12. Juno – Queen of the Gods, she is Jupiter's wife and sister, as well as sister to Neptune and Pluto, daughter of Saturn and the mother of Mars, and Vulcan. She is also the Protectress of Rome, and the month of June is named after her
13. Jupiter – Ruler of the Gods, he is also known as the God of the Sky, Lightning and Thunder. He is the son of Saturn and brother of Neptune, Pluto and Juno, who is also his wife, and he was also considered the Patron God of Rome
14. Lucifer – Light bearer
15. Luna – Goddess of the Moon
16. Mars – The son of Jupiter and Juno, he is the God of War and is regarded as the father of the Roman people because he was the father of Romulus, the legendary founder of Rome; March is named for him
17. Mercury – God of Trade, Profit, Merchants and Travelers

18. Minerva – Goddess of Wisdom, Learning, the Arts, Sciences and Medicine, she is the daughter of Jupiter
19. Neptune – God of the Sea, he is the brother of Jupiter, Pluto and Juno; he is recognized by his trident
20. Notus – South Wind
21. Pluto – God of the Underworld
22. Saturn – God of Agriculture
23. Venus – The Goddess of Love and Beauty
24. Vesta – The daughter of Saturn, she is the Goddess of the Fire, both sacred and domestic, and one of the most worshipped of the Roman Gods
25. Victoria – Goddess of Victory
26. Vulcan – The God of Fire, Blacksmiths and Craftsmanship, his forge is located beneath Mount Etna
27. Zephyr – West Wind
